Tribal Lifeline: FREE Basic Local Phone Service Or

a Reduced Price on Internet Service

- Eligible Tribal customers can receive <u>FREE</u> basic unlimited local telephone service through the Federal Tribal Lifeline Program. This <u>does not include</u> enhanced calling features such as voice mail, caller ID, call forwarding, internet or long distance telephone service.
- Unlimited Basic local telephone service provides access to emergency, operator, interexchange, and directory assistance services.
- With Tribal Lifeline your basic local telephone service is <u>FREE</u>. Without Tribal Lifeline you would pay \$24.50 per month for basic local telephone service (plus any applicable fees & surcharges.)

Or...

 You can receive the Lifeline discount on your 10 Mbps internet service. If 10M isn't available, the discount can apply to 4 Mbps or 6 Mbps internet service.

<u>FREE</u> Phone Connection through the Federal Link-Up Program

- Along with <u>FREE</u> basic local phone service, Tribal customers eligible for Link-Up will receive <u>FREE</u> telephone connection for first-time service at their residence.
- The Link-Up discount does not cover installation of wiring inside the house.
- Sacred Wind provides an inside wiring installment plan for their Lifeline customers to spread this cost over a 12 month period.

Toll Restriction Service – Keeping Your Monthly Phone Bills Low

- For customers participating in the Federal Tribal Lifeline program, Sacred Wind provides Toll Restriction Service at no charge.
- To help keep the cost of your telephone down, Toll Restriction Service restricts callers from making long distance calls. Even with this toll-restriction program, you will still be able to place long distance calls using a pre-paid calling card.
- Our customers may also control the cost of long distance calls by subscribing to our Unlimited Long Distance Service for \$20.00 per month.

Qualifying for Tribal Lifeline and Link-Up

This federal telephone assistance program provides monthly discounts for qualified Native American customers on their basic local telephone service, making this service **FREE**.

- **Eligibility** for Tribal Lifeline requires residence on tribal land & <u>evidence of participation</u> in one of the following programs:
 - Head Start
 - Food Distribution Program for Indian Reservations (FDPIR)
 - Medicaid
 - Food Stamps (SNAP)
 - BIA General Assistance Program
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Public Housing Assistance Program, including Section 8, Tribal
 - Tribal Temporary Assistance Needy Families (TTANF)
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Pension Benefit

Or...

- ▶ You may also qualify for Tribal Lifeline by meeting certain household income requirements and will need to provide evidence of income with a <u>copy</u> of one of the following documents:
 - Last year's federal or state income tax return
 - Retirement or Veteran's Statement of Benefits
 - Divorce Decree showing alimony or child support
 - Social Security Statement of Benefits
 - Pay Check Stubs
 - Tribal Notice Letter of Participation in General Assistance

New Federal Lifeline Rules

- '1 per-household-rule' means that there can only be 1 Lifeline benefit participant in a "household"
- A "household," as defined for Lifeline purposes, is a person(s)living at the same address and living as an "economic unit"
- More than 1 "household" could live at the same address and each could receive Lifeline benefits
- To retain federal Lifeline benefits, a Lifeline recipient must re-certify annually.
- Willfully making false claims to receive Lifeline benefits is a violation of federal law.
- Only eligible consumers may enroll in this program and Lifeline benefits are non-transferable
