Beginning on July 1, 2014, New Mexico’s Personal Care Options program (Medicaid) will require each care provider to use the new Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) system to report their daily work hours. The EVV is part of the State of New Mexico Human Services Department Centennial Care Program.
