SACRED WIND COMMUNICATIONS OPENS NEW HEADQUARTERS

Sacred Wind invites Federal, State and Navajo tribal officials to Dedicate its New Headquarters in Yatahey, NM, beginning with a Navajo Blessing Ceremony

Yatahey, NM, June 16, 2009 – Sacred Wind Communications, Inc., (“Sacred Wind”) a New Mexico telecommunications company, today announced that it officially dedicated the opening of its recently constructed Headquarters in Yatahey, NM. This dedication took place on Monday, June 15, 2009 in Yatahey located at 875-D U.S. Highway 491.

Several officials from the Federal Communications Commission, New Mexico State Government, McKinley County administration, and the Navajo Nation government participated in the dedication of a company that has a unique mission: to deliver new telecommunications services to the many unserved areas in northwestern New Mexico.

A traditional Navajo Blessing Ceremony commenced in the morning on Monday, June 15, 2009, followed by a 9:00AM dedication and ribbon cutting ceremony. There was, also, a tour of Sacred Wind’s new Company Headquarters.

Sacred Wind has developed and has nearly completed the installation of a fixed wireless network across much of the Navajo Nation’s lands in New Mexico, as well as a few adjacent rural communities. It has partnered with Fujitsu Electronics Corporation in a successful field trial of a fixed wireless system that provides 70 Navajo homes in the

Rock Springs and Tsayatoh Chapters near Gallup with basic and high speed Internet services. The trial has been accepted by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Development Office for full deployment across northwestern New Mexico, beginning this year.

Sacred Wind purchased part of Qwest's territory in northwestern New Mexico in late 2006, and has built offices and warehouses in Grants, Bloomfield, and now, Yatahey, New Mexico. Over the past two years, Sacred Wind has hired 40 people, has invested over \$15 Million in new telecommunications infrastructure, mainly in McKinley and San Juan Counties, and has introduced new services to an underserved and unserved population. It operated an Internet training center in Huerfano, NM, assisting school children with after-school research and introducing e-commerce opportunities to the many tribal artisans in the Four Corners area.
